2017 KALIBER 9 WEISSBURGUNDER

The fragrance of Kaliber 9 is reminiscent of a spring meadow with many white flowers, hay, pear, yellow melon and ripe lemon.

On the palate, this Pinot blanc forms a white-fleshed fruit base, with tart and grainy serious accents reminiscent of dandelion flowers. Even a slight saltiness is noticeable. Powerful enamel and smashing. A strong, not very fruity wine. Mineral, direct and straightforward.
