**2016 AUF DEM HAUN SPÄTBURGUNDER**

Medium garnet red with transparent accents. A complex interwoven aroma emanates from the fragrance of this Pinot noir, sweet, warm scents of honey and dried figs, plums, orange peel, wild strawberries, resin and gingerbread, cassis, stinging nettle, wild boar, mushrooms, assam tea, dried rose petals and sun-warm earth are included. Also cherry, pepper, bacon and smoke as well as iron and tobacco. On the palate, this Pinot noir presents itself with silky-soft tannins, which expressively bring out their accents in an interplay with an emotionally balanced fruit acid. The wine is complex and differentiated at the same time, dry yet juicy, light and heavy like watercolors of fruit and spice, power and elegance. A Pinot noir with massive Burgundy fruit, cultivated to the last detail. Great volume and a wonderfully long final.

Fermentation on the skins (14 days),
