Garnet red. In the fragrance, hints of raspberry and wild strawberry, cranberry, cassis, leather, geranium leaf and a touch of oil paint and shoe polish. In addition, minty reflexes with iodine and sea spray, meat and blood, cocoa powder and black pepper.

Very fine and delicate in the mouth with fruit and spice, force and elegance, power and lightness. The tannins are smooth and have grip at the same time, thereby deep and long. A Pinot with a leg in Burgundy and a leg in Ingelheim. A figurehead for the excellence of the Ingelheim terroir.
