### 2011 KALIBER 20 BROWNING BABY

A red blend of 20 percent Pinot noir - the rest remains a secret.

Kaliber 20 lies with a black core in the glass, decorated with a bold purple edge. Hints of blackberry, black pepper, pine scent, pencil shavings, cold smoke and dark chocolate ascend from the red wine. Caramel and cranberry, also gooseberry, bacon, peppers and ratatouille mingle with it. On the palate, a sophisticated elegant, soft tannin, which paves a silk road on the tongue. The interaction among the varieties gives the wine a high degree of integrity, which seems effortless and relaxed, just as if everything had grown together in the vineyard. The soulful sweetness of the fruit continuously remains committed to the dry side. Browning Baby is a homogeneous red wine - exposition, execution and finals are an intense and harmonious experience of taste.

special winter seed, yield reduction, harvest in  
several steps

**VINIFICATION:**

Fermentation on skins, vinification 12 months  
in traditional wood barrels, 12 months ripening  
in bottle
