2012 KALIBER 15 RIESLING

A Riesling from our Sonnenhang and Schlossberg sites, whose soils are shaped by limestone, clayish marl and loessic loam. Miniatures of apricot and peach, lemon, tangerine and grapefruit, licorice, anise and fennel, also maritime ideas of seaweed discreetly mascara the fragrances. A real nice tension at the palate emanates from Kaliber 15, it is the literal calm before the storm. The wine is firmly built from healthy, ripe Riesling grapes that have never gone to the risk. 2012 was a good, balanced year. Here the year is bundled as an extract in the bottle. A relaxed fruit acid stimulates the sip and gives it a three-dimensional drive on the palate. Crisp freshness allies with seriousness and a genuine mineral depth.
